NATIONAL ASSESSMENT PROGRAM LITERACY AND NUMERACY (NAPLAN)

Next week students in Years 3 and 5 will participate in NAPLAN. They will be assessed in reading, writing, language conventions (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and numeracy. The testing will be online this year, which is a change. With the exception of the Year 3 writing task, which will be hand written in a booklet, as in previous years. We will be commencing the testing on Tuesday, 15 May and anticipate completion by Friday, 18 May. If you have any questions about the testing please speak to your child's teacher or a member of the executive team.

STAFFING NEWS

We have had 7 preservice teachers in last week participating in their first practicum. We have a strong connection with the University of Canberra and work closely together to ensure that teacher education students have enriching school based experiences.

KEEPING STUDENTS SAFE

This week students will participate in a 'lock down' drill. Safety drills are a routine part of the Workplace Health and Safety practices at Macquarie and are conducted several times throughout the year. They prepare students with skills and knowledge to assist in managing unusual circumstances that may require evacuation or remaining inside the school buildings. While Macquarie teachers take great care and skilfully support students during these events, from time to time drills provoke questions and sensitive responses.

PARENT EDUCATION WORKSHOPS

This week two of our amazing teachers, Karen and Monique are presenting a workshop for kindergarten families about reading at home and how families can support emerging readers develop their skills. I hope you are able to attend the workshop from 6pm on Thursday in the kindergarten classrooms.

TEACHER LEARNING

Last Tuesday afternoon our staff participated in the first session of Team Teach training. We learnt how pushing buttons can lead to conflict, how to identify our own buttons and how to recognise when children's buttons are pushed. We learnt about the conflict cycle and how many opportunities there are to de-escalate situations to avoid conflict. This learning supports staff to work proactively with students to help them avoid and resolve conflicts as they progress through schooling.

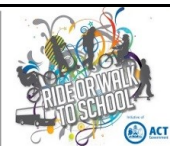
