From our Principal

Dear Families and Friends,

I am delighted to finally be here. I am having a wonderful first week so far and have thoroughly enjoyed getting to meet many of you and your fabulous children. I thought I should share a bit about myself and my professional journey to this point.

My family moved to Canberra in May of 1977 and I started school at Hackett Primary (sadly now closed). I continued on to Watson High (also closed) and finished my schooling at Dickson College, where my son is now in Year 12! After a bit of a false start at Uni (which resulted in an extended trip to Europe), I completed my teaching degree in 1996. My first teaching position was at Holt Primary School and in my second year I was right here at Macquarie. I had a Year 3/4 class and was in the room that is now our library. While lots of things are the same, there are some pretty noticeable differences — our kindy space wasn't there and the front of the school has had quite a makeover. From here I moved to Flynn Primary, then took several years away from education to have my two children, John and Lily. When returning from maternity leave I went to Evatt Primary initially as their teacher librarian. I was at Evatt for a number of years and over that time had many roles from class teacher, literacy and numeracy co-ordinator and a number of leadership roles. In 2012 I moved to Ngunnawal Primary as their Literacy and Numeracy Field Officer, a role focussed on building the capacity of teachers to cater for students' learning needs in those areas. During my time at Ngunnawal I was promoted to Deputy Principal. Last year I acted as the Principal at Taylor Primary for 8 months and I have most recently had a short period in the Education Directorate where I was leading a student engagement team for the Tuggeranong network. However my heart is in schools working with students, staff and families to ensure learning needs are being met. So I am very excited to begin my time at Macquarie.
