# MAKING A CONTRIBUTION TO SCHOOL

## HOW CAN I CONTRIBUTE TO MACQUARIE PRIMARY SCHOOL?

Financially...

**Voluntary Contributions** - each year families are asked to make a contribution which goes towards improvements to learning environments and building and maintaining classroom resources. In 2022 the suggested voluntary contribution amount is \$70 for one child, \$120 for two children and \$150 for three or more children attending the school.

**Library Trust Fund** - all donations over \$2 to our library trust fund are tax deductible and funds will be used to build and maintain the library. For more information please see the Library Trust Fund information flyer.

**Stationery packs** - each year students are provided with consumable items that they need in the classroom. Families are asked to make a contribution to cover the cost of these packs. Prices vary depending on the year level. Information is available on our website or at the front office.
