# CYBER SECURITY FOR KIDS

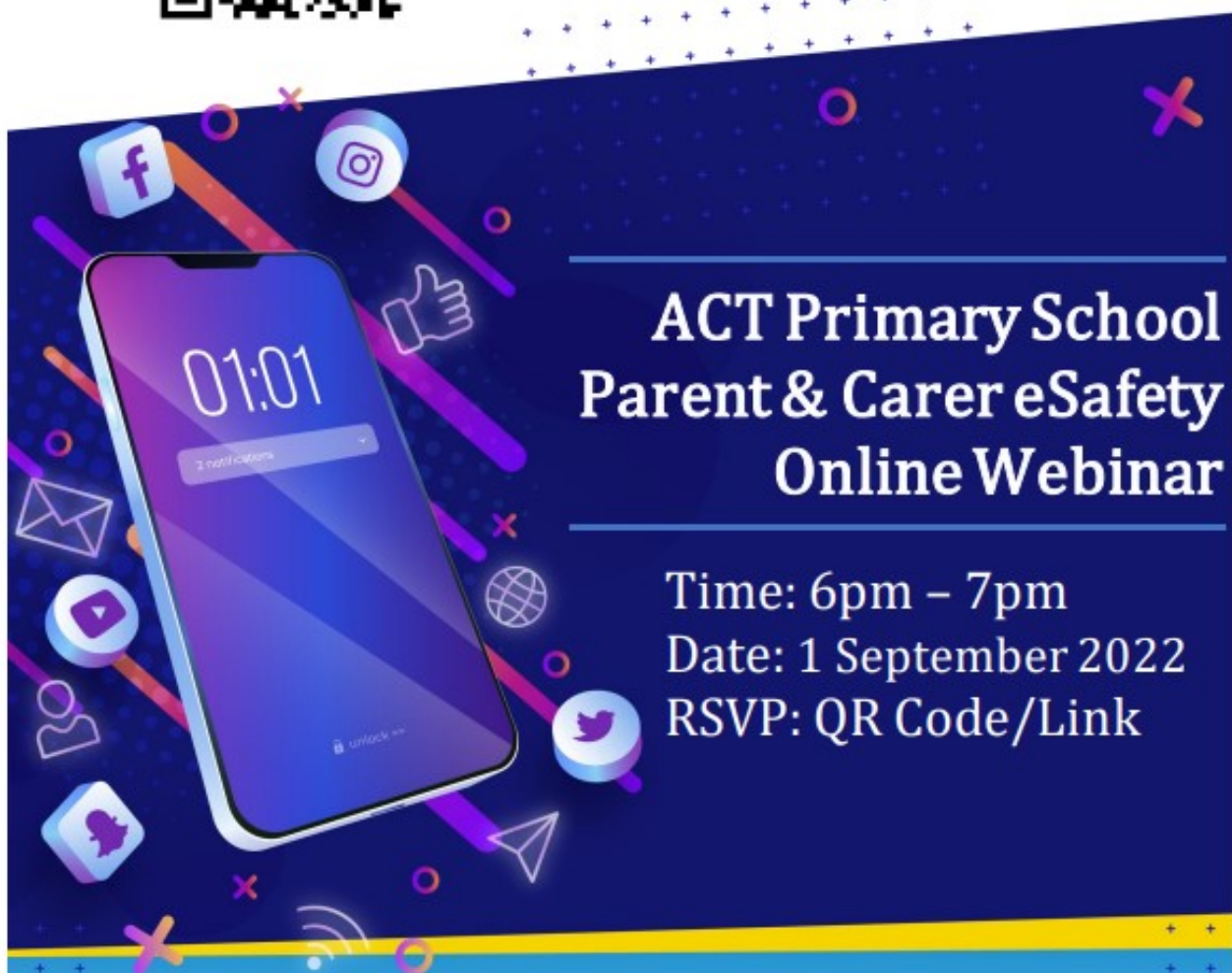
